Coastal Acres Campground welcomes dogs because we recognize they are part of your family. We appreciate the 'petiquette' of your family pet. Please follow the below Guidelines for camping with your dog at our campground:

1. Dogs are not allowed to roam freely around the campground or site and must be on leash at all times. This is for the safety of other pets and campers;
2. Please always pick up after your dog and dispose of trash in the proper receptacle provided around the camp. Bags are sold in the camp office if you do not have a bag;
3. Please avoid bringing your dog into the pond at the back of the property;
4. Maximum number of dogs at any site is two (2);
5. Do not leave your dog(s) unattended at your site or in your camper.

These Guidelines are in place so all campers can enjoy their camping experience. You will be asked to leave if the guidelines are not followed.

Tips for camping with your dog:

1. Make sure your dog is up to date on all shots and vaccinations and have copies of records with you.
2. Make sure your dog is registered at check in and has an identification tag.
3. Use a crate for sleeping, traveling or short term holding.
4. Bring your pet's food and medications.
5. Bring extra leashes, toys, treats and collars.
6. Be sure to keep your dog cool and hydrated, especially in the summer months.
7. Pack some first aid items and the telephone number for a local pet hospital for emergency situations.
8. Exercise your dog at the local dog park or take walks around town or the campground.
